Knowledge Bureau is the publisher of over two dozen certificate courses leading to the prestigious MFA<sup>TM</sup> (Master Financial Advisor) and DFA-Tax and Bookkeeping Services Specialist Designations. Under her direction, Knowledge Bureau is the only business school of its kind providing core specialization opportunities in tax, retirement, business succession and estate planning for advisors in family tax and wealth management practices.

Evelyn has been influential in advising governments on tax and financial literacy policies. She was appointed by former Finance Minister Flaherty to the <u>Federal Task Force on Financial Literacy</u>, and by the former Premier of Manitoba, Gary Filmon, to the Lower Tax Commission, to advise on the direction of the provincial tax regime. She has co-founded the <u>Manitoba Financial Literacy Forum</u> in partnership with the Manitoba Securities Commission, dedicated to increase financial literacy in that province.

She is also a well-known national commentator, keynote speaker and budget analyst who has written thousands of articles, most recently in MoneySense Magazine, and for the Toronto Stock Exchange. Throughout her career, Evelyn has spent countless hours volunteering her time on news, talk shows and chat lines from coast-to-coast explaining rights and opportunities in filing tax returns to millions of Canadians.
